A bowler must bowl at least 2/3 games of the regular season to be eligible for 'Bowler of the Year' the award. After all point totals are calculated, the point total will be divided by the number of games bowled by that bowler to get a point value per game of bowling. The highest number on that point value will determine the winner of the "Bowler of the Year" award. One award for "Male" and one award for "Female".

Example: 84 points divided by 78 games bowled equals 1.077, that number will be compared to other bowlers in the running for the award.

Regular Season Awards criteria:

- Only one individual league award per person. Must bowl at least 1/3 games to be eligible for regular season awards, and to participate in roll-off and/or tournament.

- National awards, Bowler of the Year awards, and most improved awards are not included (i.e. independent of other awards).

Individual league awards will be prioritized as follows:

1
Scratch series (Male & Female)
Scratch game (Male & Female)
Handicap series (Male & Female)
Handicap game (Male & Female)

An award for season long high scratch average (both male and female) will also be given.

An award for most improved bowler (both male and female) will also be given.

Post-Season Tournament awards criteria:

Tournament awards will be given for the following categories:

-Top Overall Singles High Scratch Series (Male & Female)
-Top Overall Singles High Handicap Series (Male & Female)
-Top Overall Doubles High Scratch Series
-Top Overall Doubles High Handicap Series
-Top Overall Team High Handicap Series

It is possible to win multiple awards in the post-season tournament.
